What are Living Gifts?

A **Living Gift** is a way to honour a person you care about by giving a gift that makes a social contribution. This gift represents services or goods you buy from a charitable organization as a gift for a loved one.

How does this work at Saint Columba House?

You can buy your loved ones **Living Gifts** through Saint Columba House. A Certificate describing the gift comes inside a lovely card made in the Saint Columba House Hand-in-Hand art program.

What kind of Living Gifts are available?

- \$20 = 4 Christmas dinner meals for low-income families during the Christmas season at St. Columba House..
- \$50 = 20 hot meals for children in the St. Columba House Alternate School offering children a pre-school head-start program.
- \$60 = 4 hours of one-on-one tutoring for children struggling with reading and mathematics in the St. Columba House After-School.
- \$100 = a summer day camp registration at St. Columba House for one child without other options for summer recreation.
- \$200 = the participation for one month of an intellectually-challenged adult in the Saint Columba House Hand-in-Hand day program.
